- Entrance fee: 2,50 per person. Donations welcome.
- The minimum age for visitors to the museum is 14 years.
- The museum is not barrier-free and is only partially suitable for people with a reduced mobility.
- Since the museum is located on the Rolls-Royce site, access for visitors from "risk states" cannot be granted in every case. An official ID card (identity card, passport, etc.) must be presented before being granted access to the site.
- The information and regulations listed in the Visitor Regulations (Information Sheet for Visitors to the Factory Museum) apply.

Notice for visitors to the Works Museum.
