Visitor Regulations and Information Sheet

Due to its location within the secured premises of the Rolls-Royce site, visits to the museum can only take place under specific regulations. In addition, the well-being and safety of visitors and employees are of great importance to us. Please therefore observe the following information and regulations, which you fully accept upon receiving or being read this information sheet and by entering the factory premises:

- ◆ Access to the factory premises and to the museum is granted:
 - after prior registration and confirmation has been completed
 - after registration at the reception desk, for which an official ID (identity card, passport, etc.) must be presented
 - only when accompanied at all times by a museum guide or an assigned company representative
 - after completion of the required safety briefing (as outlined in this information sheet)
 - after receiving the visitor pass and after receiving or being read the "Information Sheet for Visitors to the Works Museum"
- ◆ Entering the factory premises is done at your own risk and of your own free will.
- ◆ The factory premises and the museum are not barrier-free. Visitors are permitted to remain only inside the museum, in the immediate area surrounding it, and on the direct route to and from the museum.

- ◆ The visitor pass must be worn visibly.
- ◆ The current hygiene regulations of Rolls-Royce Deutschland applicable to the Oberursel site remain in effect.
- ◆ The data protection information of Rolls-Royce Deutschland relating to museum visits will be sent upon request or can be reviewed at the reception desk..
- ◆ A heightened duty of care applies on the factory premises; please pay particular attention to vehicles (trucks, forklifts, etc.). Use the pavements or the designated pedestrian pathways.
- ◆ No liability is assumed for personal belongings or valuables.
- ◆ The minimum age for museum visitors is 14 years.
- ◆ The museum is not barrier-free and is only partially suitable for people with mobility impairments.
- ◆ The museum is located on the Rolls-Royce factory premises; access for visitors from “high-risk countries”, therefore, cannot be granted in all cases.
- ◆ Carrying dangerous objects or hazardous materials is prohibited.
- ◆ Bringing animals onto the premises is prohibited.
- ◆ Smoking is prohibited on the factory premises and inside the museum.
- ◆ Photography and filming are prohibited on the factory premises. It may be permitted inside the museum and in its immediate vicinity following coordination with the company or museum representative supervising the visit.
- ◆ During museum visits and events, photographs and video recordings may be taken, particularly for press and public-relations purposes as well as for historical documentation (for example, for publications by the association in printed materials or on its website, or for distribution to press organizations). Unless you inform us at the time of registration, but no later than three days before your museum visit, that you do not wish to be photographed or filmed, we will deem this as your consent.
- ◆ Do not touch the exhibits. Doing so may result in injury, contamination, and/or damage.
- ◆ All instructions issued by the museum guides and supervising staff are to be complied with.
- ◆ The visitor pass must be returned upon leaving the factory premises.

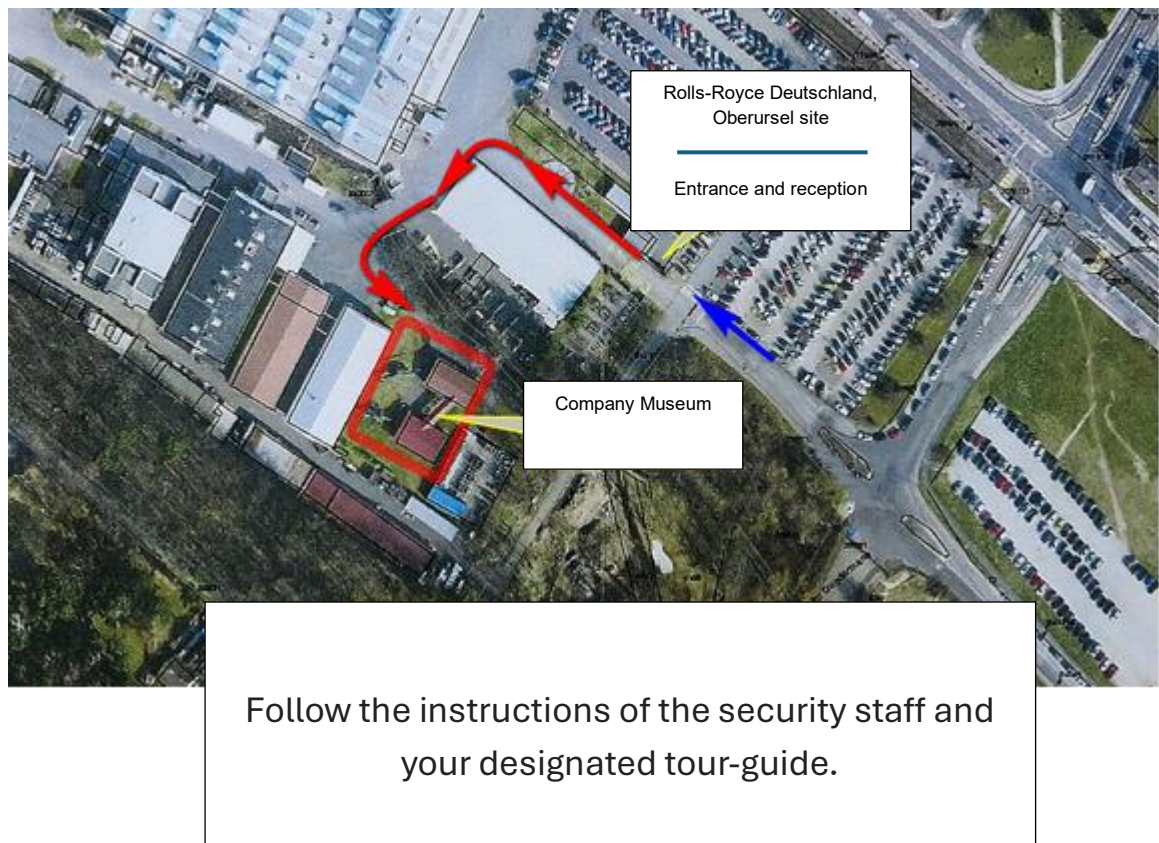
In case of emergency:
